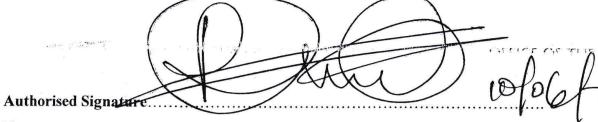
THIS NOTIFICATION of Award, submission of a Performance Security, and Letter of Acceptance shall constitute formation of a contract between your Company and the University as follows:
